We would like to reiterate our appreciation for your prompt and collaborative response to the Christchurch tragedy, which helped limit the exposure to and impact of the terrorist's video and manifesto in Australia.

These URLs are derived from a list circulated by [REDACTED]
via email to the Australian Federal Police and eSafety Commissioner on 9 April 2019.

The video and the manifesto have been classified as Refused Classification by the Classification Board as:

- advocating the doing of a terrorist act, and
- promoting and inciting in matters of crime and violence.

Additionally, the Classification Board judged that the video should be 'Refused Classification' for the way its depiction of crime, cruelty and violence offends against standards of morality, decency and propriety generally accepted by reasonable adults.

Given the refused classification status, the high impact of the video and manifesto, and the explicit manner in which both praise and encourage the doing of a terrorist act, the eSafety Commissioner strongly supports the continued blocking of relevant domains by your members.

The attached list of URLs and domains are those from the list provided by [REDACTED] that still provide access to the items as at 10.00am Friday 26 April 2019. I trust this will assist your members in their blocking efforts.
