We have blocked 122,500 subnets belonging to Australia. We used the Internet registry to determine the proper subnets to use, but this doesn't mean we will have 100% of the IP's blocked. If anyone is able to see anything on 153news.net from Australia subnets please let us know the first 3 octets of the IP address xxx.xxx.xxx and we will figure out why it wasn't blocked.

To whom it may concern,

Tomorrow morning at 9:00 am, 153news.net will be blocking over 10,000 ip blocks of all known Australia subnets. It should effectively shut down any access from Australia to any 153news.net services.

After we shut down Australian access we will begin a formal legal reply which will prove beyond a shadow of a doubt that the video you mentioned in your complaint is not abhorrent or violent in any way. We have analyzed this video and our researchers have confirmed the use of cgi, mannequin dummies, fake / no blood, and many anomalies that are not consistent with a real event.

Our goal is to help educate you to what a real event is and help you to better focus on real criminals doing evil things.
