I refer to the complaint that you lodged with the cyberReport team 23 July 2016 about certain online content.

The cyberReport team has investigated your complaint. At the time of the investigation, it was found that the material was not prohibited content in accordance with Australian law (the *Broadcasting Services Act 1992*).

Our decision concerning the content was made with reference to the National Classification Scheme. This is the same scheme that applies to traditional media such as films, DVDs and computer games.
