I refer to the complaint that you lodged with CyberReport on 19/07/2016 about certain online content.

The cyberReport team has investigated your complaint and found that the content was substantially likely to be prohibited content in accordance with Australian law (the Broadcasting Services Act 1992).

It was also found that the content is hosted outside Australia. In these circumstances, we are required by law to notify the content to accredited providers of internet filter software.

Our decision concerning the content was made with reference to the criteria within the National Classification Scheme. This is the same scheme that applies to traditional media such as films, DVDs and computer games.
