eSafety Women do training for support workers who work with women with intellectual disability.



The training helps them support women who have technology abuse happen to them.



Technology abuse means someone uses things like computers or phones to do bad things to people.



This might be things like

- Bully people online
- Make people do things they do not want to do
- Send people mean and scary texts.



We found out from the support workers what they think about our training.



We wrote a report about what we found out.

Summary means we only talk about the most important things from the report.


What we did



We worked together with a company called Orima Research.



They helped us find out what the support workers think about our training.



We wanted to know if the support workers

- 1. Know more about technology abuse now
- 2. Learned something new from the training
- 3. Changed the way they do things after the training.



Orima Research asked the support workers to do a survey before and after the training.



Survey means a list of questions they have to answer.



They also talked to some of the support workers a few weeks after the training.

What we found out



Almost all of the support workers said they are happy with the training and the information.



Most of them said they will tell other support workers to do the training.



This is what we learned about the 3 things we wanted to find out more about.



Do they know more about technology abuse now?

Only some of the support workers said they knew a lot about technology abuse before.



After the training most of them said they now understand what technology abuse is.



They said they now understand how it helps their work when they know about technology abuse.



Did they learn something new from the training?

Most of the support workers said they learned something new from the training.



They were happy with the information they got about technology abuse.



They learned what technology abuse is.



They learned how to get the right support for a woman that has any kind of abuse happen to her.



This could also be **domestic or family violence**.



Domestic or family violence means someone from your home or family does very bad things to you.



Did they change the way they do things after the training?

Most support workers said they will change the way they do things after the training.



Most said they use some things from the training in their work now.



Some use things from the training to change the way they

- Support women with their technology
- Talk to women about technology abuse.
