In addition to the factors outlined in the notification sent to Twitter re ACA-2023-0183688, Tweet 5 has been assessed as likely to cause serious harm because:

a) An ordinary reasonable person would conclude that the tweet, posted by the same end-user as the previous tweets, is intended to cause the Complainant, s47F, serious psychological harm by building on the previous tweets to add to the seriously harmful and offensive narrative about the Complainant abusing her biological child for breastfeeding them, which would not have otherwise been alleged if not for the Complainant's gender identity as a transgender woman. The end-user's intention to spread this narrative is evident in their repeated s37(1)(c) encouraging users to s37(1)(c)

In making this determination it has been considered that the Complainant has advised s47F and

b) An ordinary reasonable person in the position of the Complainant, an Australian adult who identifies as a transgender woman, would regard the tweet as being offensive in all the circumstances because it adds to a seriously offensive narrative s37(1)(c)
