



Reporting Severe Online Abuse

Severe online abuse can affect anyone and can include issues like sharing intimate images without consent or sending content that is severely harmful to another person's mental or physical health.

If you or someone you know is experiencing severe online abuse, you can report the abuse and have the content removed.

Report severe online abuse to the online platform or service first - this is often the fastest way to have it removed.

If the provider does not act quickly or does not respond to the request, you can report the abuse to eSafety. Find out how to report content on each platform at esafety.gov.au/key-issues/esafety-guide.

Report the issue to the eSafety Commissioner

eSafety's investigation team can review the issue and determine the best course of action available.
