Use these conversation starters at your workplace on Safer Internet Day to help encourage meaningful discussions about online safety.

1. How do you protect your personal and work information online? Are there any tools or practices you've found helpful?

Share practical tips and tools staff can use to keep their data safe.

2. What steps can we take as a workplace to foster a culture of online safety and respect?

Opens a conversation about building a positive digital culture in the workplace.

3. What's one online safety issue you think gets overlooked?

Helps highlight risks people might not usually talk about.

4. Have you ever had a situation where you felt unsafe or uncomfortable online? How did you handle it and how can workplaces support employees in similar situations?

Encourages sharing real experiences and what support could help in the future, particularly in a workplace context.

5. How can AI tools be used safely and responsibly at work?

Prompts a timely discussion about balancing benefits with risks like privacy and misinformation.

7. Have you ever had to help someone with an online safety issue - like a friend or family member?

Encourages discussion about tips to support those most at risk of online harm including children and older people such as elderly family member.

8. Now that Australians under 16 are prevented from accessing some social media services, what support do they need to prepare for access?

This discussion encourages people to reflect on screen time and digital boundaries.
