Teacher notes

These notes support eSafety's Virtual Classroom webinar, **'Be an eSafe kid: Safer Gaming with the Mighty Heroes'**. The webinar is designed to help students understand how to navigate online friendships using the skills of responsibility, respect and getting help and support. Students will be introduced to some of the Mighty Heroes characters and learn how to apply the key social skills they need to game safely. This webinar is a great introduction to the new eSafety game 'Robo Raven and the Ancient Relics: A Mighty Heroes adventure', which launches on Safer Internet Day 10 February 2026.

About the webinar

As part of an integrated online safety program, this webinar can be used to check knowledge and support conversations with students and their families. It aligns with the Australian Curriculum in the key learning areas of Digital Technologies, Health and Physical Education, Humanities and Social Sciences and English.

Print copies or organise access to an editable PDF on a device if you would like students to answer the questions on the student worksheet.


Joining the webinar

Join the webinar through the link sent in your registration email. Please log on at least 10 minutes before the session. You will be asked how many students will be attending in your learning space. It is preferable for each learning space to have its own registration.

The webinar will run for approximately 40 minutes.

Students can participate by:

- listening to the presenter
- recording answers to the questions on the worksheet (optional)
- responding to the teacher-facilitated discussions (teachers use the webinar chat box to record and share the students' answers)
- taking their worksheets home and sharing their learning with their parents and carers.
