

# Recognising stereotypes and peer pressure

A Virtual Classroom webinar for Year 5 and 6 students



These notes support eSafety’s live Virtual Classroom webinar **‘Recognising stereotypes and peer pressure’** and the optional post-webinar quiz designed for Year 5 and 6. Students will recognise stereotypes and peer pressure interactions. Through an online gaming scenario, students will identify these harmful behaviours and learn how to rebuild relationships, as well as know where to seek help and support.
